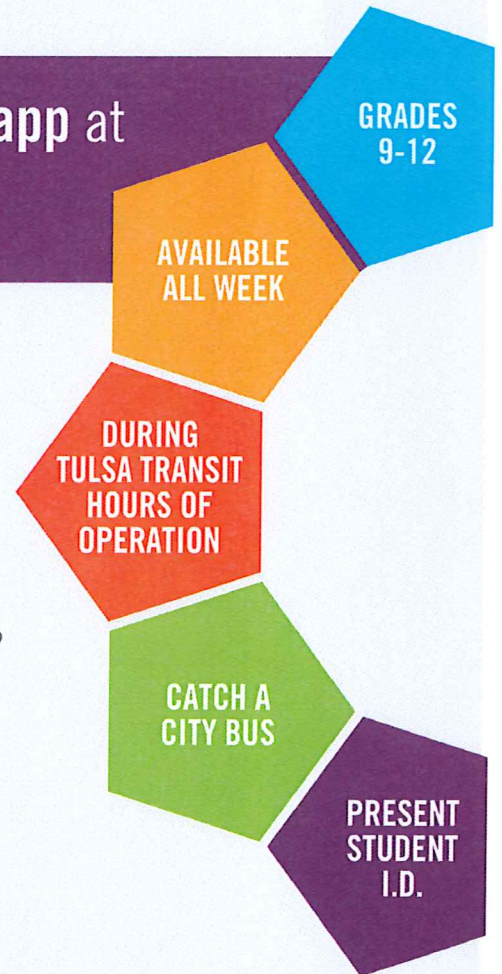

Modus

- Modus is a volunteer-based transportation service that ensures teens get to their appointments consistently, on-time and safely anywhere in the Tulsa area.
- The service is for teens who are accessing appointment-based social services, such as doctors, dentists, counseling/therapy, school enrollment and job training.
- Modus envisions a community in which the barrier of transportation is removed and all teens can access the services they need so they can reach their full potential.
- Modus connects Tulsa teens to a fleet of community drivers who truly care about each and every individual they transport. We are currently recruiting community drivers!

ModusEd

- ModusEd is an in-school travel-training program that ensures teens have the knowledge they need to use transit to get to school, part-time jobs and higher education opportunities.
- It uses a customized 20-minute training which includes a Transit Passport, a 7-day pass and hands-on in-class experience with a transit expert.
- ModusEd enables teens to access the entire city on their terms, by redefining independence through mobility.
